TOUR ITINERARY** **DAY 1 - SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 7**

Departure from Toronto approximately at 4:50 pm from Terminal 1 on Air Canada airlines for Tel Aviv. Check with Ari Bauer for connecting flights to Toronto.

DAY 2 - SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 8

Arrive in Tel Aviv at 10:15 am, where our tour guide will meet us. We begin our tour in Jaffa/Joppa, affording us a breathtaking view of the city of Tel Aviv. Jaffa is a picturesque port city of winding alleys, art galleries, and craft boutigues. King Solomon had the cedars of Lebanon rafted here for the building of the first Temple in Jerusalem. Jonah departed from Joppa (Jon. 1:3) to Tarshish. We'll visit the site of the house of Simon the Tanner and the Tabita School where Tabitha was raised from the dead (Acts 9:36-43). Transfer to our hotel for check-in. Balance of day at leisure. Dinner and overnight at the Herod Hotel, Tel Aviv.

DAY 3 - MONDAY. SEPTEMBER 9

We'll drive along the Plains of Sharon; the Mediterranean; and the old coastal road, the Via Maris, the ancient trade route between Egypt and Babylon. We stop at Caesarea, the fortress city built by Herod the Great. Here Pontius Pilate had his base; Cornelius lived and was baptized (Acts 10); Paul embarked to Tarsus (Acts 9:30); and Philip preached (Acts 8:40). Visit the Roman theatre, hippodrome, Crusader City. We'll ascend Mt. Carmel, where the prophet Elijah challenged the 400 false prophets of Baal (1 Ki. 18:20-30). Megiddo, one of King Solomon's walled, fortified cities (1Ki. 9:15), the book of Revelation will come alive about the final battle of Armageddon. Then we'll visit the Nazareth Village, a reconstruction of the first-century Nazareth; then stop at Mt. Precipice for a magnificent view of Jezreel Valley. We'll travel to Cana of Galilee where Jesus performed His first miracle, turning water into wine. Dinner and overnight at the Nof Ginossar.



DAY 4 - TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 10

After breakfast, we begin our day with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee to Kibbutz Ginosar, the museum housing an ancient boat from the time of Jesus. Continue to Capernaum, the centre of Jesus' Galilean ministry and the site of many of His miracles (Mt. 8:5-17; Mk. 2:4). We will see the remains of Peter's house and the synagogue site where Jesus taught and worshipped (Mk. 1:21; Lk. 4:31). Drive to the Sea of Galilee to the Primacy of St. Peter at Tabgha. Continue to the Mt. of Beatitudes where Jesus delivered what is perhaps the most famous sermon ever preached, the Sermon on the Mount (Mt. 5-7). We will then proceed to the site of the city of Korazim (Mt. 11:20-24). Dinner and overnight at the Nof Ginossar.



DAY 5 - WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 11

We start the day at Hazor, a horse and chariot city from the time of King Solomon. Continue to Tel Dan to see the ruins from Abraham's time and the Dan Spring, a source of the Jordan River. Continue to Banias, one of the sources of the Jordan River and the site of ancient Caesarea Philippi, where Peter made the confession of faith in Christ (Mt. 16:16). Drive to the Golan Heights and the foot of Mt. Hermon, the highest mountain in Israel, for a panoramic view of the corner of Israel, Syria, and Jordan from Mt. Bental. Visit Kursi, where a man was healed from demons (Lk. 8:26-39). Dinner and overnight at the Nof Ginossar

DAY 6 - THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 12

Our day begins at Harod Springs, the site of the biblical battle from the time of Gideon. Driving southward to Beit She'an, we will walk through the extensive excavations of the largest ongoing archaeological dig in Israel with its Roman theatre, colonnaded Roman streets, mosaics, and Roman bathhouses. It is the city where the Philistines nailed the bodies of King Saul and his sons to the wall (1 Sam. 31:10-12). We will stop at Gilgal where Joshua set up 12 stones, for the Tribes of Israel (Joshua 4:10-24). Stop at the Jordan River where Elijah ascended in a fiery chariot (2 Ki 2:1-12 Tel Mar Elias). Now we will ascend Up To Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem at the Dan Panorama Hotel. Jerusalem.

DAY 7 - FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 13

We will drive to the top of the Mount of Olives for a panoramic view of Jerusalem. Tracing the footsteps of Jesus, we'll descend down the Mount of Olives, to the Garden of Gethsemane. We will read Matthew 25:31-40 about the Kidron Valley, We will enter the old city of Jerusalem by Stephens gate as we continue along the Via Dolorosa, visit the Pools of Bethesda, St Anne's Church, Pilate's Judgment Hall. Now we will go to Mt. Zion to visit the traditional site of the Upper Room, King David's Tomb and then to visit the high priest Caiphas' house. Drive to the Garden Tomb/Gordon's Calvary for a communion service. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem at the Dan Panorama Hotel.



DAY 8 - SATURDAY. SEPTEMBER 14

Drive to Qumran to see the caves where a young shepherd boy discovered the Dead Sea Scrolls in 1947. We stop at Ein Gedi oasis where David fled Saul. Continue south to Masada and ascend by cable car to the summit of this magnificent fortress built by Herod the Great and the last stronghold of the Jewish Zealots. We now drive to the Dead Sea for a chance to float in the saltiest body of water in the world. Dinner and overnight at the Dan Panorama Hotel, Jerusalem.



Today we drive to the Valley of Elah where the battle of David and Goliath took place. Continue to Beit Shemesh to read from 1 Samuel 6:1–21. Visit the Valley of Aijalon (Josh. 10:1–15). Continue to Neot Kedumim, the only Biblical Landscape Reserve in the world, to see and experience the Land of the Bible as it was during the time of the Bible. Drive to Modi'in, birthplace of the Maccabees. Dinner and overnight at the Dan Panorama Hotel, Jerusalem.

DAY 9 - SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 15

Our day begins in the Old City going to the Temple Mount and Western Wall, including a tour of the Western Wall (if possible) (which is an extra cost). We will meet our guide and continue to the Davidson Center and the Archaeological Park around the southern wall excavations. At the City of David, we'll explore the excavations and learn about Jerusalem's water supply in ancient times, including the Pool of Siloam and the Pilgrimage Road. Now we'll go to the Temple Institute, an organization planning the rebuilding of the Temple. Then we'll drive to Yad Vashem, for an emotional visit to the national Holocaust Memorial and Museum. Dinner and overnight at the Dan Panorama Hotel, Jerusalem.


